Abstract

This article studies the careers of the members of the catedral chapter of Santiago, Chile during the 18th century. After a general explanation on the nature and fuctions of the chapters and its members in in Spanish America, the autor identifies the principal factors which explain the carrees of the diferente canons in this period: their academic degrees, age and place of birth and their influence and relations. Specific reference is made to the five bishops, former members of that chapter during this century —Manuel Antonio Gómez de Silva, Pedro Felipe de Azúa, José de Toro y Zambrano, Manuel de Alday and José Antorio Martinez de Aldunate- examining the circumstances in which they acceded to their benefices and, eventually, to the head of the see.
